<b>February 1st</b>	<b>New and Returning Parents:</b> Submit <b>Parents' Financial Statement (PFS)</b> online to <a href="http://www.sss.nais.org">www.sss.nais.org</a> (be sure to enter web address shown) or mail to SSS in Randolph, MA. The school code for Eaglebrook is 2944. Use estimates of 2011 income. <b>All documents are sent directly to SSS.</b>  <b>New Parents Only:</b> Submit copy of 2010 Federal Income Tax Returns, signed, and all applicable IRS 1040 schedules and W-2 Forms along with the above-requested PFS.
<b>February 15th</b>	<b>New and Returning Parents:</b> Submit copy of 2011 W-2 Forms online or mail to SSS in Randolph, MA.
<b>March 1st</b>	<b>New and Returning Parents:</b> Deadline for <u>all</u> financial aid application materials (including 2011 Federal Income tax information) to be submitted and to be considered in the first-round of decisions. Completed Returning Family applications are given first priority. After this date, decisions will be made on a first-come, funds availability basis.
<b>April 1st</b>	Financial Aid decisions will be mailed to Returning Families.
<b>April 15th</b>	Financial Aid decisions will be mailed to New Family accepted applicants.
<b>May 15th</b>	<b>New and Returning Parents:</b> Copies of all 2011 tax forms must be submitted on or before this date in order to receive any grant awarded. If you intend to file for an extension, please inform us prior to this date.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION, IF APPLICABLE:

If you own a business or farm, you will also be required to complete a Business/Farm Statement. This form is available at [www.sss.nais.org](http://www.sss.nais.org).

If these dates have passed, please submit your information as soon as possible. Because of high demand and intense competition, the financial aid budget is typically depleted by May 1<sup>st</sup>. Applicants must receive aid in the first year of attendance in order to be considered for aid in future years. We will, however, try to help families who experience unforeseen financial hardships after they've enrolled.
